## **FOOD PRESERVATION**

- 1) What is not true about procedural writing?
  - a. It contains instructions.
  - b. It dictates a way of organizing components.
  - c. It is a form of expository writing.

- 2) While giving home tasks to the children related to having conversations with family members about the theme/ activity, you notice that parents of a particular child in your class never take up the home task, hence limiting the student of rich experience sharing.
